Note 1: The new students are to pay the following additional charges: -

Note 3: For KUCCPS students, the government promises pay Ksh. 30,000 per year while the remaining Ksh. 26,420 is paid by the parent/guardian of the student. For non-KUCCPS students, the parents/guardians are expected to pay the full fee of Ksh. 56,420. In case of non-remittance by the government, the parent/guardian shall pay the difference.

Note 4: Those applicants who are not under KUCCPS are advised to register with KUCCPS on arrival at the college to benefit from the same.

Note 5: Fees payment shall not be refunded. Any excess fee paid shall be regarded as prepayment for the next term/year.

Note 6: Students are advised to apply for bursaries. They can also apply for loan from the Higher Education Loans Board (HELB) through their website www.helb.co.ke. KUCCPS students benefitting from HELB will have the balance of Ksh. 26,420 paid for them.

In order to assist students complete HELB Loans/ Bursary Application forms, parents/guardians are requested to assist the students they sponsor at the institute to obtain the following supportive relevant documents;

- KRA PIN Certificate
- National ID
- Death Certificate (in case of orphan)
- Burial Permits and any other

Note 7: Students will have to clear College fee before registering for external examinations.

Note 8: Students are required to carry both original and photocopies of the following documents on the reporting date;

- KCPE certificate/result slip
- KCSE certificate/result slip
- National ID
- Birth Certificate
- Former School leaving certificate
- Two colored passport size photographs

When you come to register, collect your registration forms from the registrar who will check your certificates and direct you to cash office to deposit your bank slip.
